CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

Should a student's enrollment be terminated or cancelled for any reason, all refunds will be made according to the following refund schedule:

1. Notice of cancellation must be made in person or by Certified Mail.
2. All monies will be refunded if the student cancels within three (3) business days after signing the enrollment agreement and making initial payment.
3. Cancellation after the third (3rd) business day, but before the first class, will result in a refund of all monies paid, with exception of \$150.00 of the registration fee.
4. Cancellations made after October 1st will result in **NO REFUNDS MADE BACK TO CAMPER.**
5. Termination Date: When calculating the refund due to a student, the last date of actual attendance by the student is used in the calculation unless earlier written notice was received.
6. Refunds will be made within 30 days of termination of the student's enrollment or receipt of a Cancellation Notice from the student.

GROUND FOR TERMINATION

A camper's enrollment can be terminated at the discretion of (BBUC) for insufficient academic progress, non-payment of academic costs, or failure to comply with rules and policies established by BBUC as outlined on the website and this agreement. Any student dismissed for these reasons shall not be afforded a refund.
